Available now for download from the Apple store and Google Play store, the Eye Need A Witness app allows users who feel unsafe to send a danger alert or a request for witnesses to anyone in the network, including local police, within 5 miles of their location using real-time GPS location and tracking. Once the network is alerted, other users can agree to be a witness and report to the caller's location to WITNESS, RECORD, and REPORT.

The Eye Need A Witness app is breakthrough technology which empowers anyone who feels unsafe to ask for help from those who are most able to respond quickly. It creates a connected community of care as a crucial link to a safer environment, and replaces MedicAlert products by providing a less expensive, more accessible, modern solution which requires no extra equipment other than the cell phone you already carry.
